2025 TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Eligibility

- Entry is open to all tennis members (including off-peak and country) who have paid their subscriptions and the £5 entry fee. (free for juniors)
- Off-peak members will be required to pay a supplementary £5.00 charge each time a match is played during peak hours.
- For age group events, age refers to age as at **31 December 2025.**
- For 50 and over events players must have been born in 1975 or earlier.
- For Youths/Juniors, please refer to the chart below.
- In doubles events, both players must meet relevant eligibility and, where applicable, age requirements.

2. Youths/Juniors

These events are all Mixed Singles - players can enter 2 age groups.

12 & Under	2013-2014
14 & Under	2011-2014
16 & Under	2009 - 2014
18 & Under	2007 - 2014

Juniors will be notified of the scoring system once entries are in.

3. Play By Dates

- Please note each round's play by date on the draw and make every effort to get matches played by the stated date. If you cannot do this, please contact the event organiser before the play by date.
- If play by dates are not met, players may be withdrawn or a coin toss made to determine the result, at the discretion of the referee.

4. Tournament Rules

- o Open events;
- This is a Seeded knock-out tournament, best of 3 tie break sets. Tie breaks to 7 and 2 ahead after 6-6. Doubles: best of 3 sets with deciding set a championship tie break.

- Vets events;
- This is a Seeded knock-out tournament, both singles and doubles to be best of 3 sets with deciding set a championship tie break.
- All court bookings should be made according to the Club rules as displayed on the Club website. Normal court booking rules apply to tournament matches. No priority to tournament matches.
- Players should complete matches within the published round dates.
- If a player is unable to play the next round, the player should concede the match if they get to match point.
- Players who reach the semi-finals must concede if they get to match point but will not be available for the final's day.
- Players must provide their own balls except for the finals weekend.
- Players enter their results on the Tournament page of the website and on the paper copy of
 the draw in the clubhouse as soon as possible after the match has been completed. If
 players have any problems doing this, they should contact the Event Organisers on
 tournaments@sheenltsc.co.uk.
- Players should contact the Event Organisers on tournaments@sheenltsc.co.uk with any
 queries or concerns regarding scheduling or results. If a match cannot be played within the
 draw date, the Event Organisers may grant an extension if the circumstances causing the
 delay are reasonable, and if it does not inconvenience the opposition in the next round
 unduly. Extensions can only be sanctioned by the Event Organisers. If the match is still not
 played the Event Organisers and Tournament Referee will decide the result.
- Any questions or disputes that arise must be referred to the Event Organisers. If necessary
 the Tournament Referee will be asked for a decision on the matter and their decision will be
 final.
- It will be up to the players to agree which court surface they will play their match on. In the event of a disagreement on which court surface to play on, players, or the Tournament Referee, will flip a coin to decide.
- Players will be automatically withdrawn from the competition if their membership lapses or they fail to pay their subscriptions at any point during the tournament.
