Off Peak members

Any Off Peak Member who plays a match during peak hours will be required to pay a supplementary £5.00 charge each time he/she plays such a match.

Entry Deadline

Entry deadline is noon on Monday Oct 21st. No entries received after this can be accepted. **For those entering the doubles, it is acceptable for one person to enter both players as long as both entry fees are paid.**

Entry fee

£5 per entrant per event.

Court availability

This tournament is expected to coincide with the resurfacing of the back courts. More time is being given for matches to be played. It is also acceptable for matches to be played at other venues (eg Dukes Meadow) if the players agree.

- 1 If both players in a singles match are BTM members the scores can be submitted to the LTA and may count towards calculating the player's rating. Scores will only be submitted if both players agree to this before the match.
- 2 All court bookings shall be made according to the Club rules as displayed on the Club website. Players are asked to complete matches within the published round dates. It is anticipated the round dates will be as follows: round of 16 by 27 January; quarter finals by 24 February and semi-finals by 11 March. Should a player be unable to play the next round, it is recommended the player should concede the match prior to match point. Players are asked to make every effort to make sure they will be available for Final's Day on Saturday 23 March 2019.
- 3 Should any Final not be played on Final's Day due to adverse weather conditions, the finalists will be free to arrange to play the match at a mutually convenient time. Provided the match is played within two months of Final's Day, the result will count and the winner's name/winners' names will go up on the Winner's Board.
- 4 The format of the matches shall be the 2 Tie Break Sets followed at set all by a Championship Tie Break. Players will provide their own balls. Balls will be provided for finals day.
- 5 Players should contact the event organisers with the match result and scores as soon as possible after the match has been completed. Players are asked to keep the organisers fully updated as to their progress in the tournament.
- 6 Players are asked to contact the event organiser with any queries or concerns regarding scheduling or results. If a match cannot be played within the draw date the organisers shall grant an extension if the circumstances causing the delay are reasonable, and if it does not inconvenience the opposition in the next round unduly. Extensions can only be sanctioned by the event organiser. If the match is still not played the event organiser will decide the result on a coin toss.
- 7 Any questions or disputes that arise shall be referred to the event organisers. If necessary the tournament referee will be asked for a decision on the matter and the referee's decision will be final.

Please Note.

The courts are often unplayable during the winter season. Players are asked to make every effort to organise their matches early within the round dates, to facilitate rearranging any match cancelled due to adverse weather conditions. The event organisers will be chasing all players to arrange their matches in accordance with the round dates. Please could all players keep the event organisers fully updated.
